The terms used in the policy have meanings specified in Chapter I of the Rights of Persons with Disabilities Act 2016.

ENABLING UNITS FOR PERSONS WITH DISABILITIES

- The enabling unit will be coordinated by a coordinator appointed by the principal.
- A counsellor-cum-placement officer will be appointed for the unit from among the college members.
- The unit will collaborate with the expert committee for people with disabilities to implement the policy for people with disabilities.
- The guidelines and regulations has been issued by the examination department for the use of scribe in exams with Disabilities (as per government regulations from time to time.)

Facilities available for Employees and students

- Half of the staff has been trained to assist people with disabilities, including those with learning disabilities.
- Disability awareness sessions are part of the student and employee orientation programs.
